DISCIPLINE AND PUPIL BEHAVIOUR POLICY

JSS School ensures that:

In our dealing with each other, the students and teachers show

- courtesy, humility, tolerance, good humor and integrity
- a spirit of enquiry, independence and personal initiative

Policy Aims:

This policy aims to

- Develop students' courtesy and respect for others
- allow students to learn and teachers to teach
- care for the environment in which we live and work

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES

If a student is in breach of school rules, **teachers** may -

- issue a warning or reprimand

A matter referred to the **Supervisor**, in addition may result in -

- a phone call or note to the boy's family
- a referral to the School Counsellor
- a referral to the Principal.

Role of the counsellor.

- Individual counselling sessions will be held for attitudinal change
- The counsellor will involve the parents if needed in handling indiscipline.

Serious breaches of discipline, eg violence, possession of a prohibited item, drugs, persistent disobedience, smoking, persistent lateness, truancy, will be dealt with in the first instance by a Supervisor.

The Principal will be the final point of referral for repeated breaches of discipline.

In some cases it is mandatory for the Principal to follow a certain set of procedures which may include notifying the police (e.g., if a student is found to be in possession of weapons or drugs) or involve the School Counsellor.

Students code of conduct :

- Students are expected to conduct themselves with dignity and poise, be polite and courteous to elders, kind and cooperative with their fellow students.
- Disrespect and disobedience may result in disciplinary action, involving suspension or even expulsion.
- Discipline must be maintained in the class as well as in the corridors, throughout the day.
- Money should not be lent or borrowed from anyone.
- Students should refrain from using abusive language in indulging in physical fights and bullying.
- No obscene literature will be allowed in school premises.
- A student who wishes to leave the class needs to obtain student pass from the teacher.
